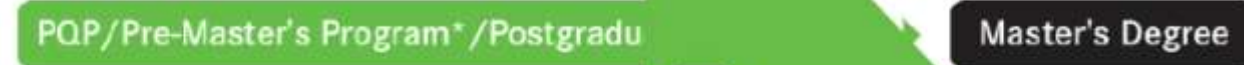

Destination	Years	Average Full Degree Cost (USD)
USA	4	\$99,333
Australia	3	\$45,414
New Zealand	3	\$53,997
UK	3	\$62,997
Canada	4	\$51,324





# Outcomes: Earn while you learn

Australia's average part-time wage per hour is one of the highest out globally.

# Outcomes: Starting salaries

Graduates of a two year degree are eligible for a post-study work visa.

Australia's average graduate starting annual salary is comparatively high.

Destination	Average Starting Annual Salary (USD)
USA	\$54,214
Australia/NZ	\$46,585
Canada	\$44,017
UK	\$40,649





# Accommodation

## Homestay

- Under 18s. Guaranteed.
- Includes meals- 1-3 times a day (dependent on preference)
- Live with an Australian family

## On-Campus

- Single room accommodation
- Usually ensuite (depends on the college)
- Internet/Electricity included

## Off-campus

- Referral service with trusted lettings agents
- More choice. Often less expensive
- Internet/Electricity not included (usually)
